

EC MALTA FAMILY PROGRAMME

Embassy Summer offers families the fantastic opportunity to learn English while exploring sunny Malta! Parents can choose to enroll in one of our adult courses, while children take part in our dynamic Day Programme.

The programme for kids of age 12 to 17 consists of daily English lessons held at a local school and social activities from Monday to Friday. English lessons alternate from morning to afternoon every week as shown on the timetables below (please note that changes might apply).





Social activities for kids are held in the mornings/afternoons when students are not in lessons. Please note, we do not offer 'Lesson Only' Programme – the Programme can only be booked with activities included.

Optional activities for Parents will be offered at school at extra charge. The parents will be attending their course at EC Malta, in St. Julian's and the lessons will be held on a double banking timetable.

LEARNING

KIDS

- Local School
 - Taught by friendly and professional English teachers
 - 20 x 45 minute lessons per week (morning or afternoon)
 - Placement test on day 1
 - Maximum 17 students per class
 - Students will be placed in an international class with students of different nationalities
 - Modern classrooms with interactive whiteboards
 - Curriculum with emphasis on communication skills
 - Materials included as well as and end of course report and certificate
 - Lunch is served at school or on activity, consisting of one hot or cold dish.

FIRST DAY

Kids need to be ready to be picked up from EC Malta (St. Julian's) at 08:30 to be taken by private bus to local school or their morning activity.

Once at school, students will attend an induction session delivered by an Embassy Summer staff member, which lasts approximately 30 minutes. They will then take a one-hour placement test that assesses their grammar, vocabulary, reading, writing and speaking.

Students are tested so they can be placed in the best class for their English level. Students will receive their Welcome Pack on the first day of school.

Parents attending adult course will receive detailed instructions about the first day closer to the course start date. Students' attendance will be recorded for each lesson and an attendance certificate will be issued at the end of the course only if the attendance is equal or greater than 80%. Students are placed according to the result they achieve on the placement test. The teachers confirm that they are in the right level on the first two days of school and if they aren't they will be moved accordingly. If students think that they are not in the right level, they can go to the Academic Office and discuss it with the Academic team.



GETTING TO AND FROM SCHOOL ACTIVITIES

A private bus service will take students to and from school and activities. Students will be picked up and dropped off at EC Malta (our adult school in St. Julian's). Parents should ensure that their children are at EC Malta (St. Julian's) every morning for the bus which departs at 08:30. Kids will return to EC Malta around 17:00. There will be one of our staff member to supervise them until their parents will finish their lesson at 18:00.

3 WEEK SAMPLE PROGRAMMES FOR KIDS

Malta Family programme for Juniors includes 5 days activities. Students take part in lessons, have lunch at the school and go on activities with the rest of the students.
