Now in its 18th year, The British English Olympics is a prestigious competition that brings together school teams from across the world to compete a variety of challenges that test students' ability to use their English language skills in a variety of situations, including presentations, debates and creative improvisation tasks. Hosted in traditional British boarding school campuses, teams take on five distinct challenges — earning points toward a place in the Grand Final. At the end of the competition all students take part in the Grand Award Ceremony in central London. Many schools compete year after year, selecting their finest students to represent their school and their country. For students it is a stage; for schools, a tradition; for parents, a moment of real pride.

THE FIVE CHALLENGES

Improvisation

Teams take on unexpected scenarios on stage requiring fast thinking, bold performances and strong teamwork under pressure.

Case Study

Students analyse a real-world problem and present creative, structured solutions to a judging panel.

Tech Challenge

Looking at the ever changing world of technology, students are presented with a brief which requires them to demonstrate innovative and creative solutions to the judges.

Speaker's Challenge

A powerful speech prepared in school before arrival. This is a chance to shine on an international stage.

Debate Challenge

School teams go head-to-head debating assigned positions to a given topic. Students must demonstrate their ability to use their English language skills and to listen and respond effectively in real time.
