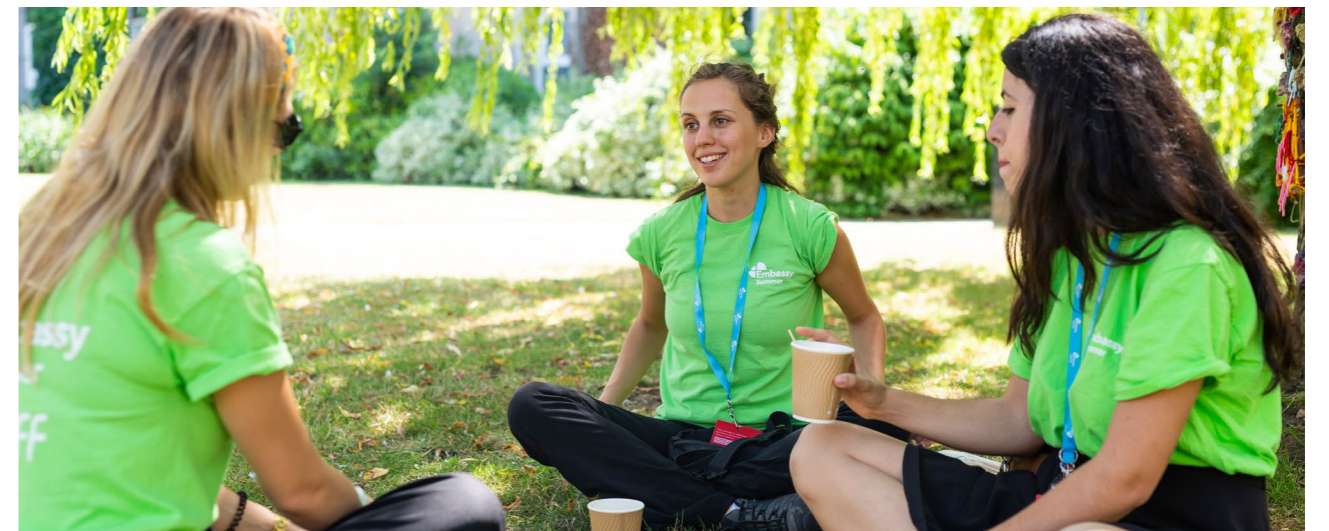


Welcome to Embassy Summer in China

- Student safety and wellbeing is our first priority.
- All of our staff are required to complete Safeguarding Level 1 provided by the British Council. All of our centre management team are trained to Level 2 standards.
- Each centre has at least one dedicated Welfare Officer whose sole responsibility is ensuring our students' wellbeing.

- We provide supervision after class & activities and during excursions.
- We have dedicated night supervisors in our centres to make sure we provide 24-hour support to our students.
- If any medical issues arise we have access to first aiders on-site for basic support, and, if required, our staff have established links with local doctors, dentists and hospitals.

Dedicated Support

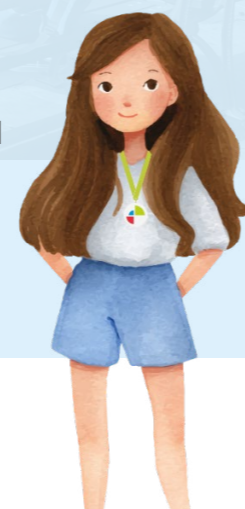
- Dedicated support provided for our students throughout their stay.

Programme Highlights



The Academic Experience

English Language Classes

Our British curriculum is based on topic based learning to explore grammar and vocabulary. We offer a wide range of topics suitable for younger learners and that focus on the students' use of the language and extending their vocabulary. Our classes average 15-17 in a class.

Our curriculum is accredited by the British Council and recognised by ACCET in the USA, Languages Canada, FELTOM (Malta) and a variety of other EFL bodies globally. Our classes are taught by foreign teachers experienced and qualified for the teaching of English providing the same level of quality in the Chinese classroom as in our British winter and summer schools.

Students joining our programmes also benefit from project work to support their development in working in small groups and they will show their final projects in a student showcase at the end of their stay.

In addition to learning inside the classroom, our programmes offer educational visits to local places of interest with students being provided with worksheets in English to complete and feedback after their trips.



The Cultural Experience

Our programmes are a fabulous mix of British and Chinese culture. Students taking part in our programme will both experience local cultural places of interest on their excursions and local visits, as well as British culture in the activities they take part in on site.

We include fun events such as our Royal Arts & Crafts Afternoon, British Etiquette Evening, and a traditional British School Sports Day. Students can take part in British children's party games, we have British Quiz Night and our Royal Family evening!

Our camps are a wonderful balance of two unique cultures.

The city combines modern innovation with traditional Chinese culture, which helps students learn about the world beyond the classroom. Shanghai provides vibrant neighbourhoods, museums, and green spaces that support educational excursions and cultural discovery. The city offers clean urban areas, and a strong focus on safety, which makes it suitable for younger students.

Vanke School Pudong is our international summer camp, also open to international students from around the world.* It is an excellent location to explore Shanghai and is only 30 minutes from Shanghai Pudong International Airport. The school is surrounded by many educational and research institutions.

The Vanke School offers our students a beautiful and safe campus environment, with high quality facilities including state of the art classrooms for learning, incredible indoor and outdoor sports facilities, lecture halls and a large dining hall for breakfast, lunch and dinner (Day students will be provided with lunch each day).

For our residential students, our centre in Shanghai offers high standard on campus boarding in rooms of 2 – 4 people. The boarding school is designed with a suite model similar to that of British and American universities, creating a homely space for our students.

*please note that we expect our international students to predominantly be age 13+ although the camp is open to international students of all ages

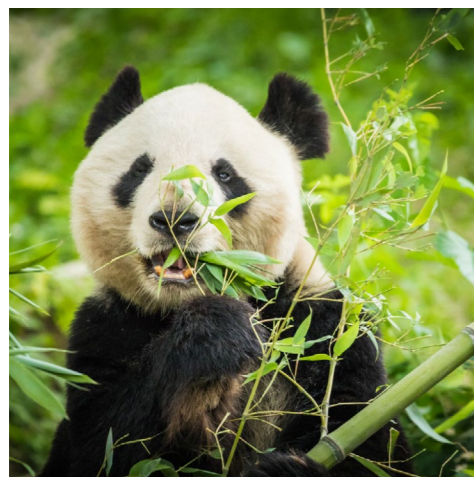

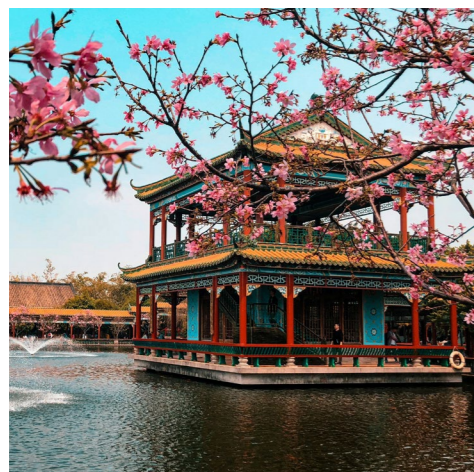
